For Advanced we will have the CIVA 2010 rules as a base, with exceptions used in the last couple of years to run the competition without a big administrative burden.

Judges

Chief Judge will be Graham Hill from UK, assisted by Nick Buckenham. Our aim is to have five scoring FAI registered judges this year and at least one from each Nordic country. From Czech Republic we have one invited FAI registered judging team on the line.

Avgas 100LL and for oil; Castrol Multigrade or AeroShell straight 100

For registered pilots fuel and oil will be invoiced from Swedish Aerobatic Federation.

Limited possibilities, contact Contest Director.

Entry fee

Entry fee for participating pilot including closing dinner

And transportation to and from the closing dinner 150 Euro

Entry fee will be collected at registration upon arrival, payment in cash.

There will be no landing fees for participating aircrafts.
